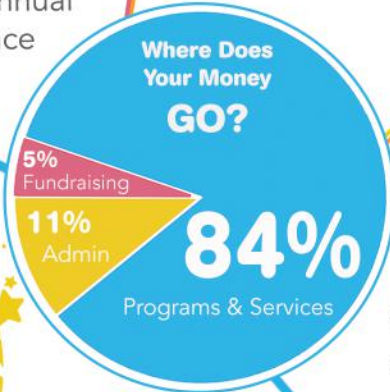
## FAMILY SUPPORT
