



# WANTED: children with Childhood Apraxia of Speech



## WHO?

- Children between 4 and 9 years old
- Growing up in English-speaking homes
- Normal hearing and nonverbal cognitive skills
- Diagnosed with (suspected) **Childhood Apraxia of Speech (CAS)**

## WHAT?

- CASTLE Camp: Speech therapy summer camp (8 am – 3 pm) for children with CAS
- Includes 16 hours of individual speech therapy & camp activities with other children with CAS

## WHY?

- To evaluate and improve speech therapy for children with CAS

## WHERE?

- CASTLE Center (Childhood Apraxia of Speech Treatment, Learning, and Evaluation) in the Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders at Temple University

## WHEN?

- Summer 2019 (7 weeks: 6/17 - 8/2) plus several visits before June 17 (see below)
